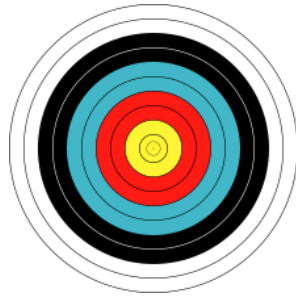


Water Day - Don't forget to
drink plenty and wear sun cream!

- Create a target using paper, cardboard, coloured pens and pencils. Find somewhere sensible outside to set up your target. Throw water balloons, or a small ball (a pair of socks will do) at your target.



- Set up some paper cups or tin cans and try to shoot them down using a water pistol. If you don't have a water pistol, you could try to make one using a plastic bottle or use an old spray bottle.



- Have a go at making your own sprinkler using an old plastic bottle.



- Make 'sponge bombs' by drenching sponges with water. Ask a family member to throw them at you.



- Water any plants in your garden (make sure you do wait for the temperature to cool down a little so that they don't get burnt).



- Make a water wheel using paper plates and cups. Test it out in the sink or outside using a hose.



- Pierce a water-filled bag, without spilling any water!



- Make a water xylophone.
